This NASP award is given to the Specialty Pharmacy that embodies the practice of Pharmacy in the field of Specialty.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Nominee must be a NASP corporate member in good standing
- Nominee must be a licensed pharmacy that dispenses specialty drugs and provides specialty pharmacy services

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Nominee will be evaluated according to the following categories:

- INNOVATION AND LEADERSHIP IN THE FIELD OF SPECIALTY PHARMACY 30%**
- Demonstrated a commitment to enhancing and promoting excellence and innovation in specialty pharmacy
 - Have established and distinguished themselves as an innovative leader in the delivery of superior patient care and positive outcomes
 - Provide consistent and reliable leadership and education focused on assisting members of the healthcare team in the delivery of superior patient care and positive outcomes
 - Implemented programs and/or services that improve patient care, efficiency and outcomes
 - Provide outstanding service and exemplary contributions to help further the NASP mission and programs
- QUALITY/PERFORMANCE IMPROVEMENT INITIATIVES 25%**
- Demonstrated a commitment to a continuous model that results in increasingly effective clinical programs and high-touch support services measuring improved medication adherence and KPIs
- PATIENT SATISFACTION 25%**
- Provide exceptional patient support services and seamless patient care that result in consistently high levels of patient satisfaction
 - Demonstrated an improvement that increased patient satisfaction as measured by the specialty pharmacy or third party designee
- COST MANAGEMENT 10%**
- Served as an advocate for patients and offered solutions to manage out of pocket costs; provide greater value while managing cost for payer partners
- COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT 10%**
- Exemplify themselves through their contributions and support of the specialty pharmacy community, including organizations and providers
 - Is involved and committed to making the communities where they work and live a better place

SELECTION PROCESS

All nominations must be submitted to the Membership Committee by **August 13, 2021**. The NASP Membership Committee will review all nominations and score them using a blinded, unbiased, and weighted scoring process based on their merits according to the defined evaluation criteria.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- The specialty pharmacy must be nominated by an NASP corporate or individual member in good standing
- The nominator is responsible for submitting a complete award nomination
- The nomination should include a 100-to-250-word narrative for each of the evaluation criteria sections describing why the nominee merits the award
- All completed nominations forms should be submitted to awards@naspnet.org

AWARD

The Specialty Pharmacy of the Year Award will be presented at the NASP Opening General Session at the NASP Annual Meeting on Tuesday, September 28 at 1 PM ET. The recipient will receive a trophy and complimentary 2022 Annual Meeting registration. The winner will receive recognition on the NASP website, in a press release, *The Advocate*, social media, and other NASP communication materials.
