Through his active involvement with NASP and dedication to advancing the profession, he embodies the mission of NASP by elevating the practice of specialty pharmacy through the development, delivery, and promotion of continuing professional education and specialty certification.

As a CSP since 2014, his commitment to NASP is unwavering and continuous, as evident by his active participation in various initiatives and committees. His contributions to the Customer Satisfaction Committee have significantly improved patient care quality through the creation of Specialty Pharmacy Patient and Provider Satisfaction Surveys.

During collaborative meetings, David advocated for the utilization of NASP's surveys across the five University of California (UC) Health Specialty Pharmacies, emphasizing the benefits of NASP's services. Through his leadership in promoting corporate membership for UCDH, all five UC specialty pharmacies (UCLA, UCSD, UCI, and UCSF) have now become corporate members of NASP. As the first at UC Davis Health to obtain CSP certification, David sets a precedent, inspiring and guiding other pharmacists to pursue certification and excel in their practice, resulting in the current count of 7 Certified Specialty Pharmacists at UCDH, with numbers steadily increasing.

This effort resulted in the establishment of a modern 80,000 square foot facility, driven by state-of-the-art technology, aimed at improving pharmaceutical processes, and enhancing medication procurement, control, and



distribution at UCDH. This represents a significant advancement in meeting the evolving needs of our patient population.
